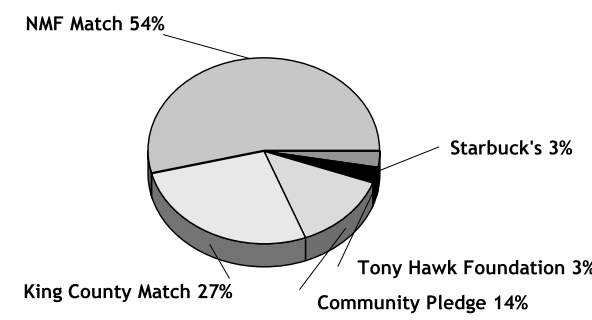

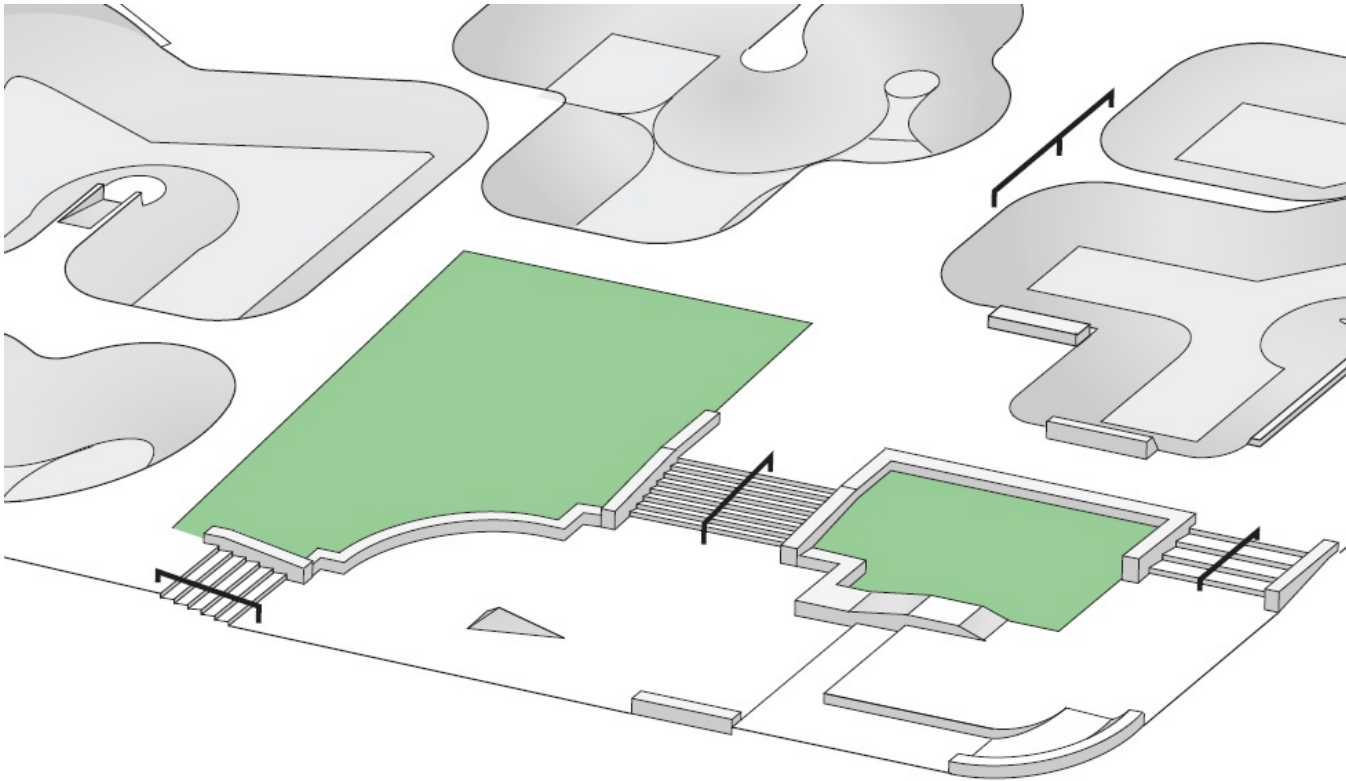

This grant project will combine Department of Neighborhoods Matching Funds (NMF) with King County Youth Sports Grant funds and private donations to design and build skateboarding features and surrounding amenities at the Lower Woodland skatepark.

In November 2005, Seattle Parks began work on Phase I of the Lower Woodland skatepark. In addition to building a world-class recreational facility for skating, the Phase I project will also lay the foundation for even more expansion in subsequent phases. The Phase I project currently has an \$850,000 budget. This is an opportunity for the community to help make a great skatepark even better!
